



Evaluation of measures put in place by the Commission to counteract the effects of the Russian import ban

Meeting of the Civil Dialogue Group Horticulture, Olives and Spirits

R 913 (peaches)

1. 33 300 tonnes withdrawn (of which 20 900 t for free distribution).
2. Union financial assistance up to EUR 9,4 million.
3. Very low uptake for Promotion measures

R 932

A total budget of **EUR 125 million**, allocated as follows:

- EUR 43 million: tomatoes, carrots, cabbages, sweet peppers, cauliflowers, headed broccoli, cucumbers, gherkins, mushrooms, plums, soft fruit, fresh table grapes and kiwifruit.
- EUR 82 million: apples and pears.

R 932

- Commission stopped receiving notifications on 10 September due to a huge request from Poland
- Final notifications up to EUR 37,3 million equivalent to around 320 000 tonnes (of which EUR 26,2 million and 230 000 tonnes for Poland ~70%)

R 1031

- 403 000 tonnes allocated based on exports to Russia plus 3 000 tonnes per MS: 487 000 t
- Total uptake by 31 December 2014: 286 000 tonnes with EUR 61 million cost
- Extended up to 30 June 2015 for main products (plus lemon) and 321 000 tonnes.
